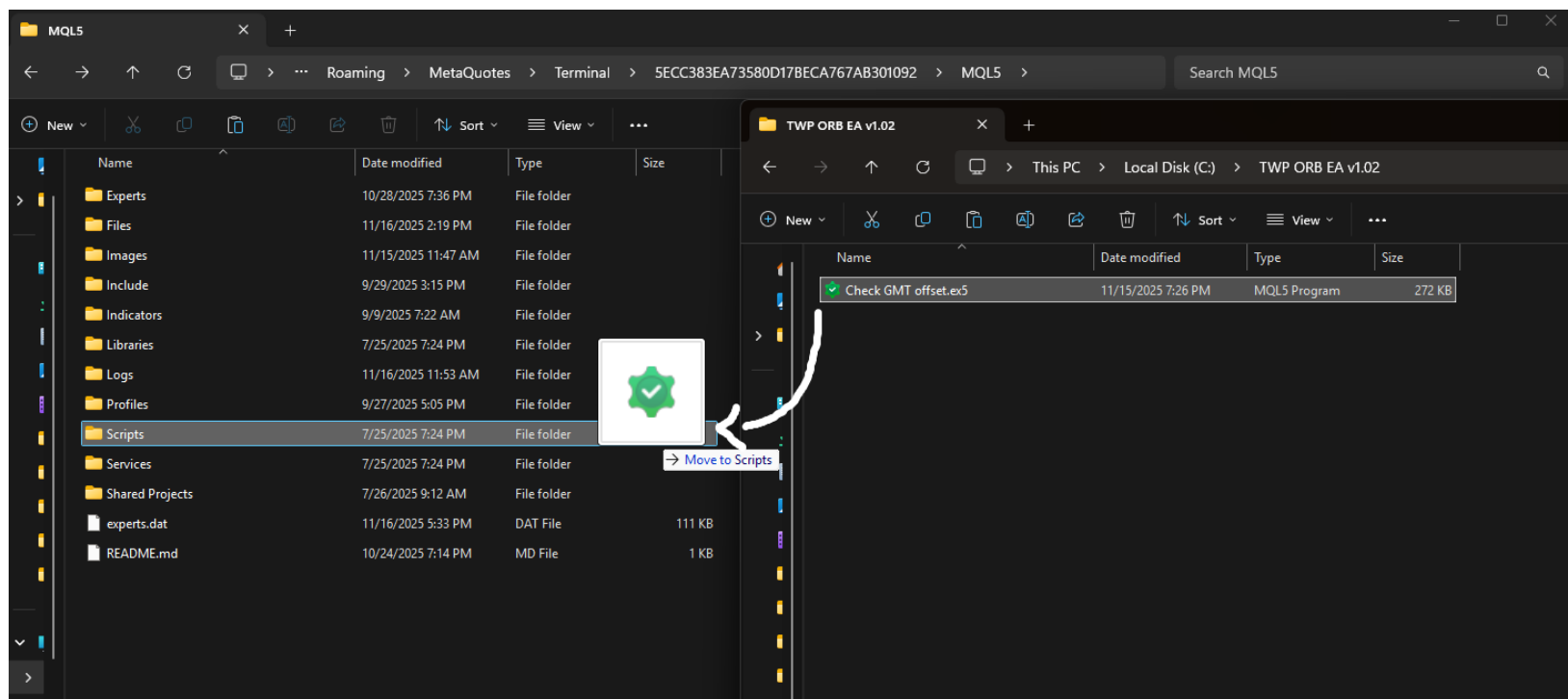


# It is extremely important to use the correct GMT setting during backtests.

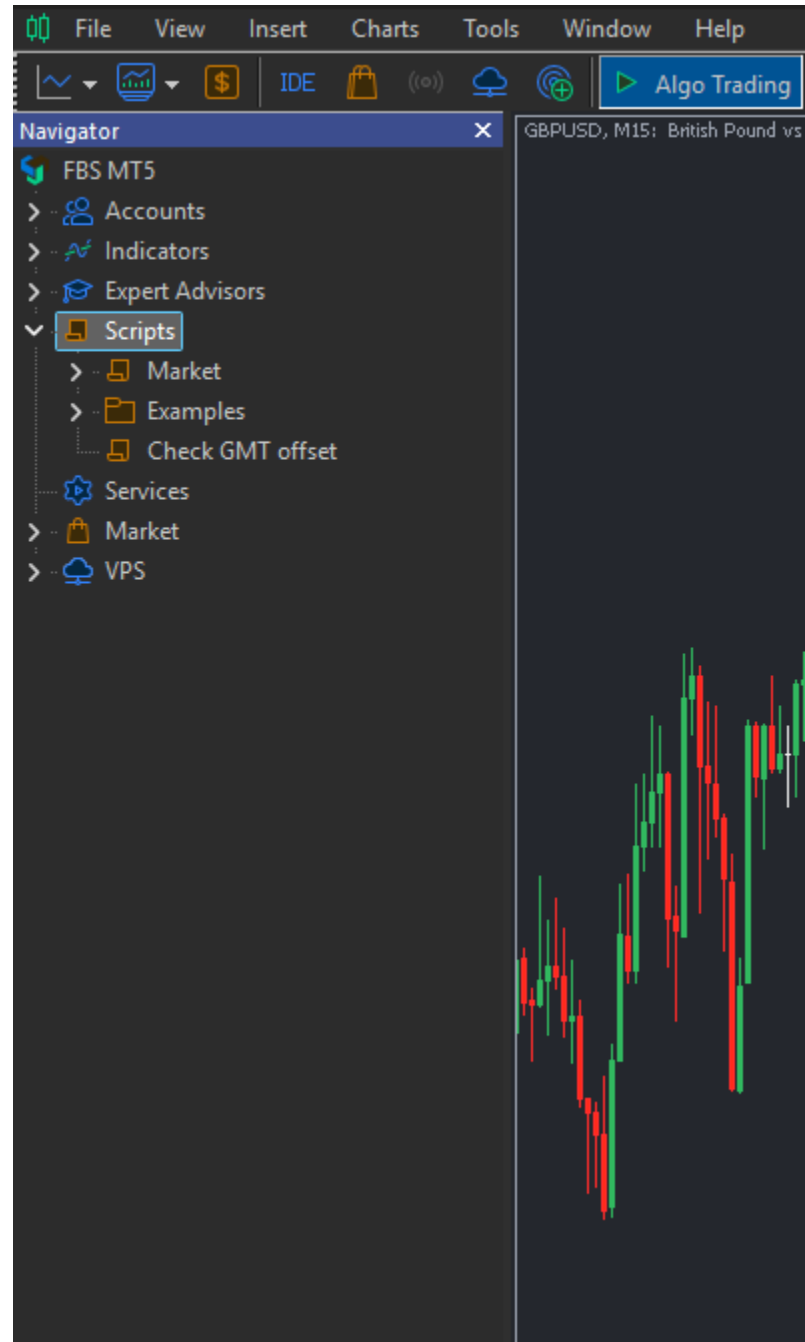
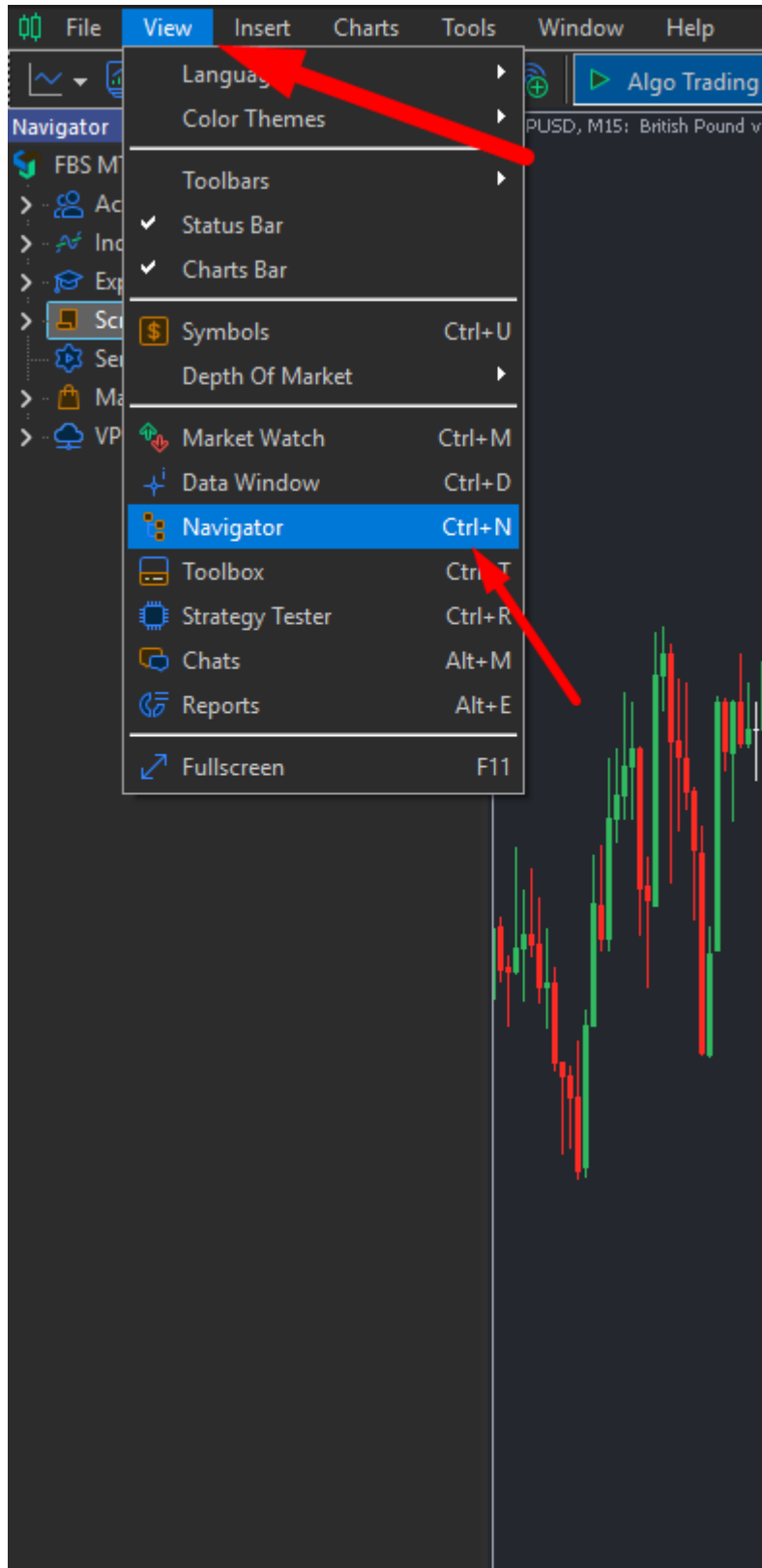
## To help users determine the broker's GMT for each asset class, a dedicated script has been created.

### How to use it:

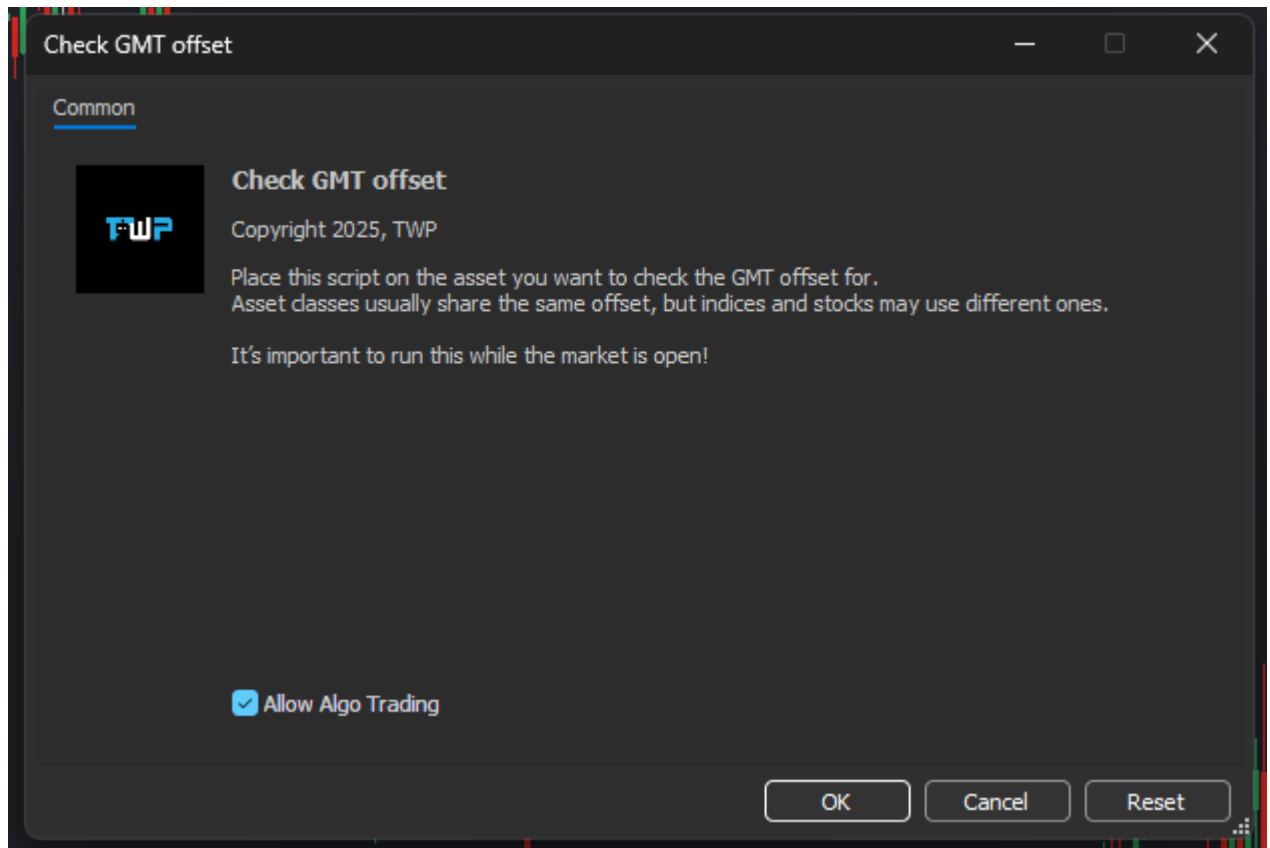
1. Place the file inside the Scripts folder located in your MQL4 or MQL5 directory.



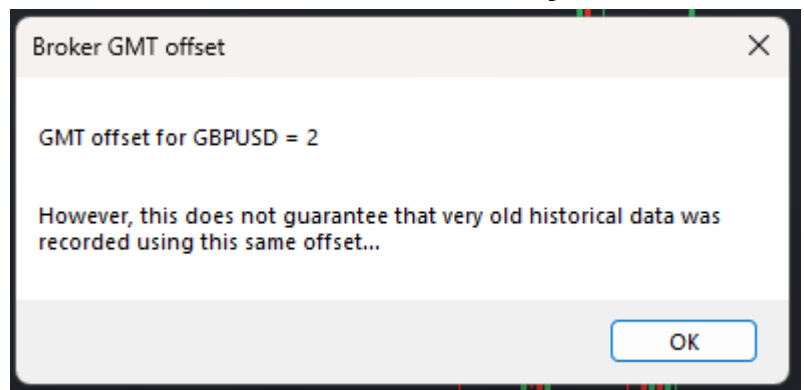
2. In the terminal Navigator, open the Scripts category.



3. Drag the Check GMT offset script onto the chart.



4. Done — the GMT used for that symbol will be displayed.
