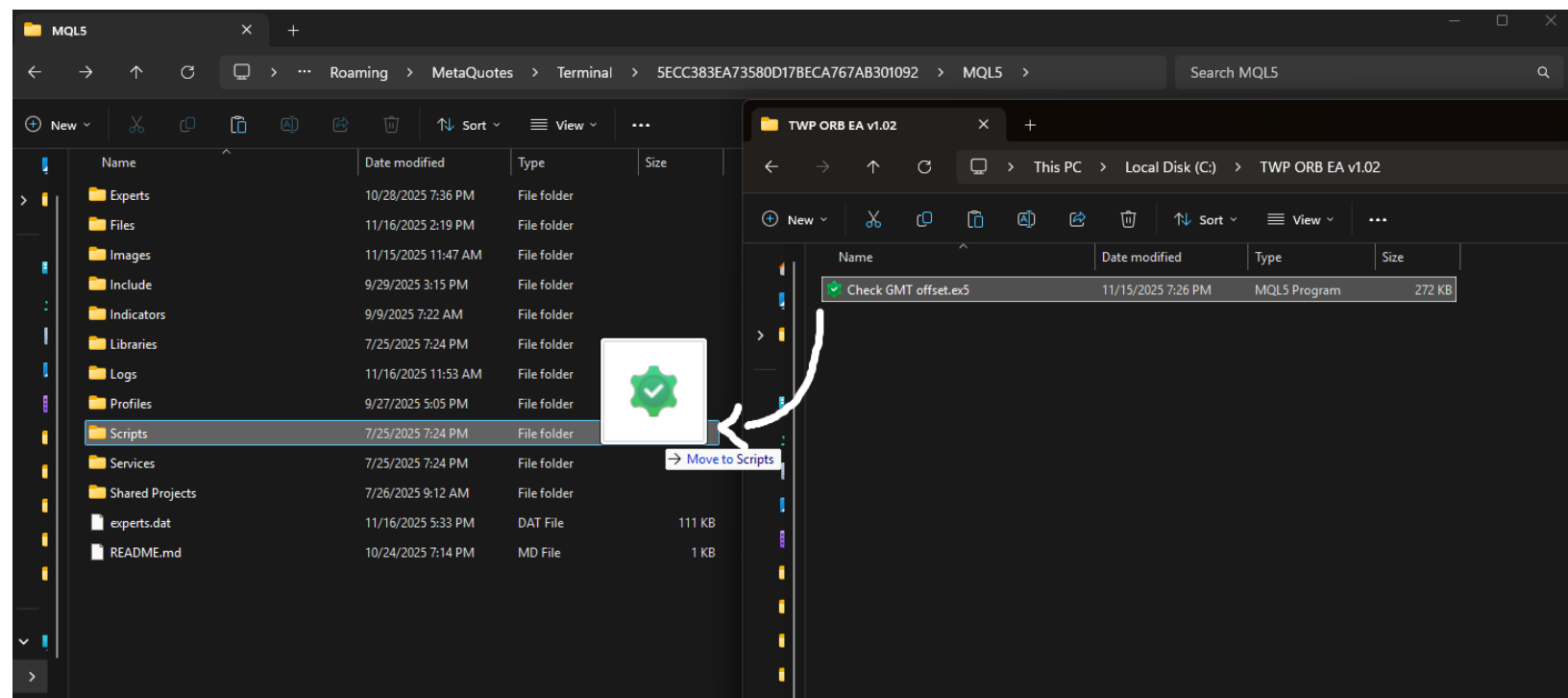


It is extremely important to use the correct GMT setting during backtests.

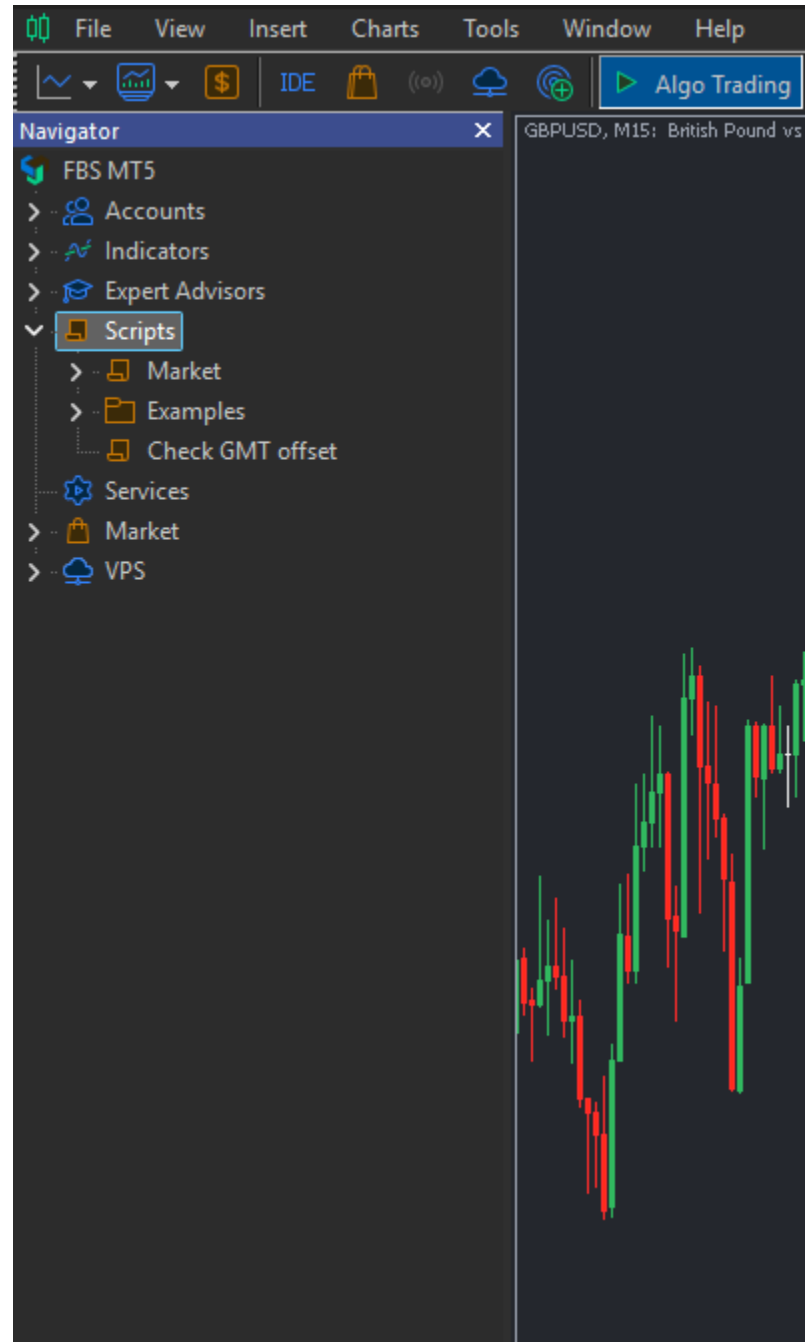
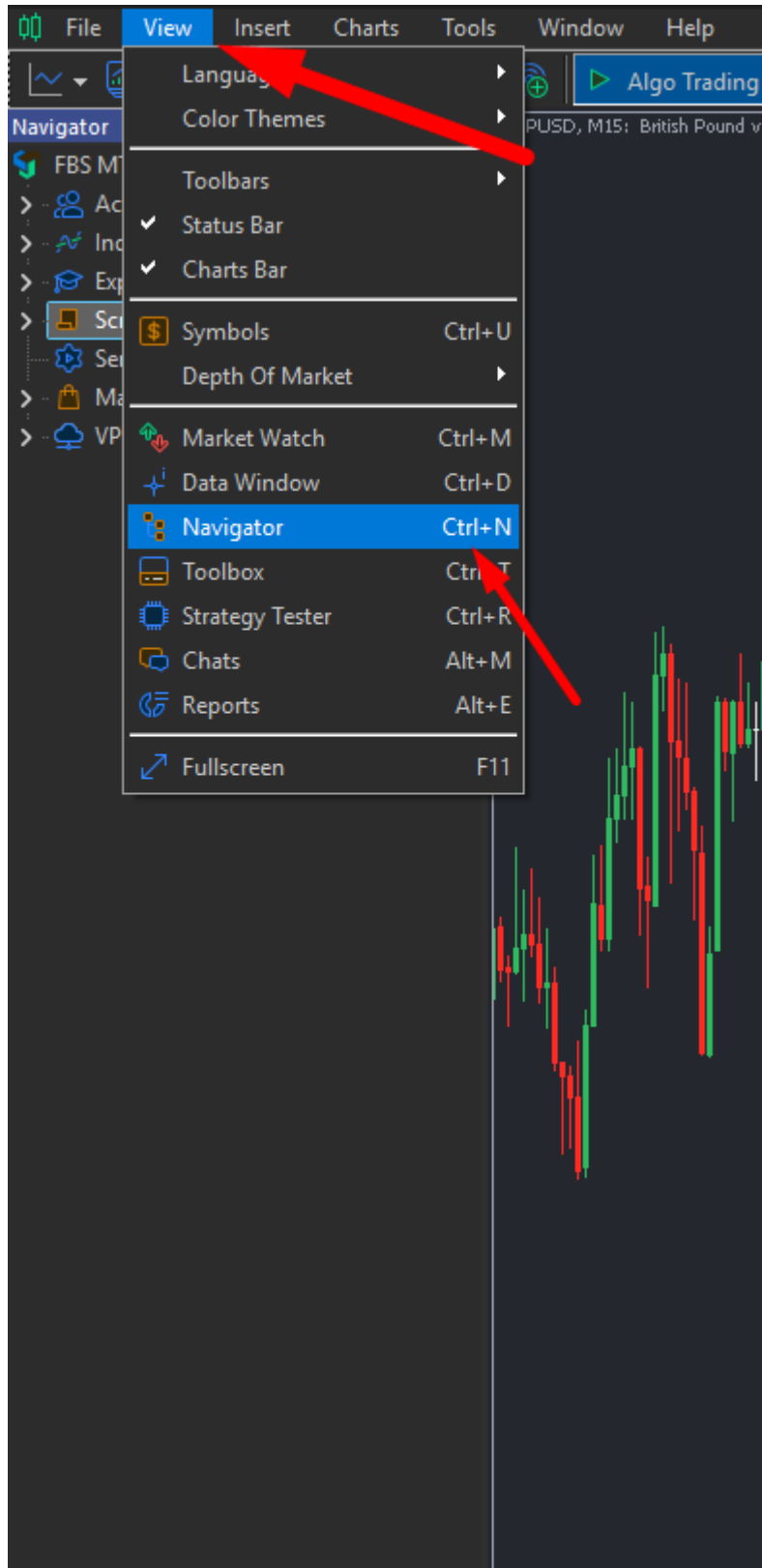
To help users determine the broker's GMT for each asset class, a dedicated script has been created.

How to use it:

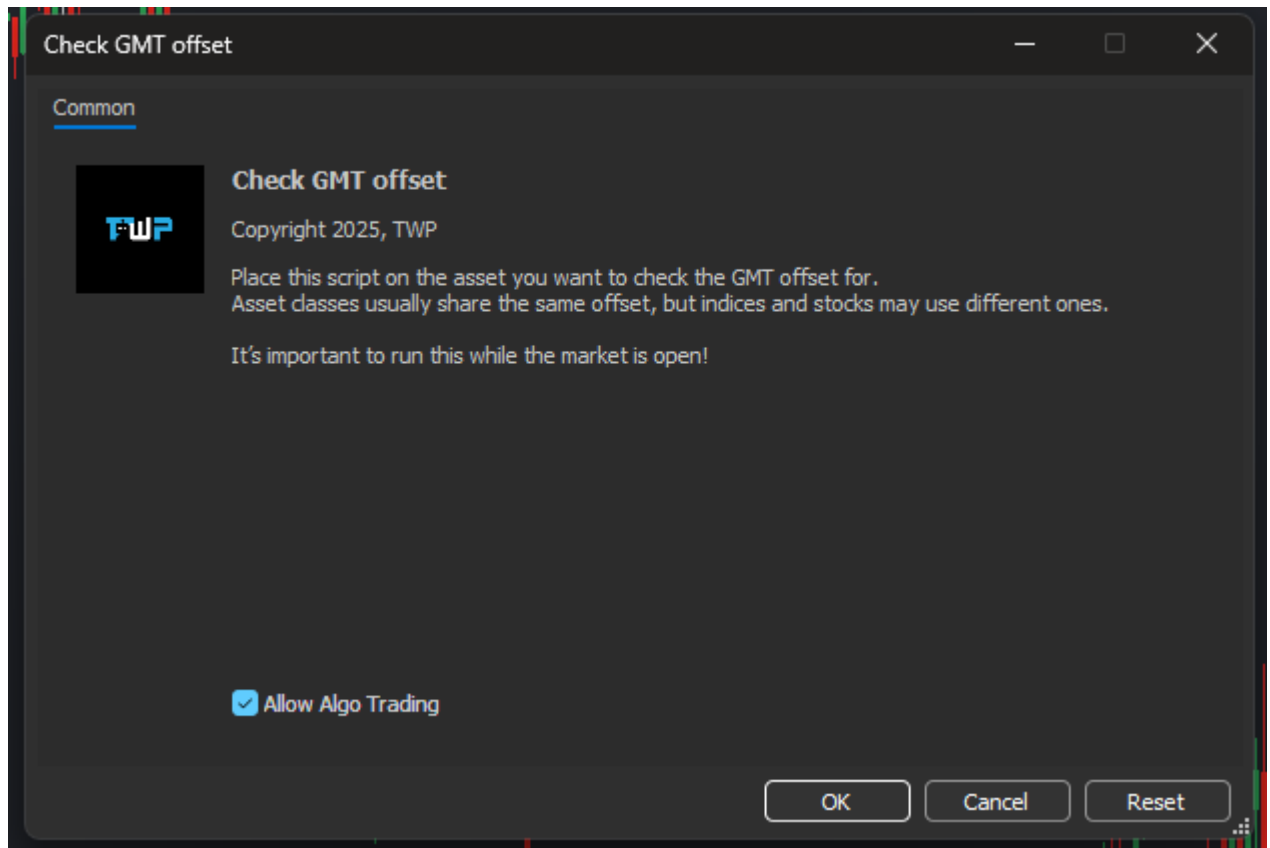
1. Place the file inside the Scripts folder located in your MQL4 or MQL5 directory.



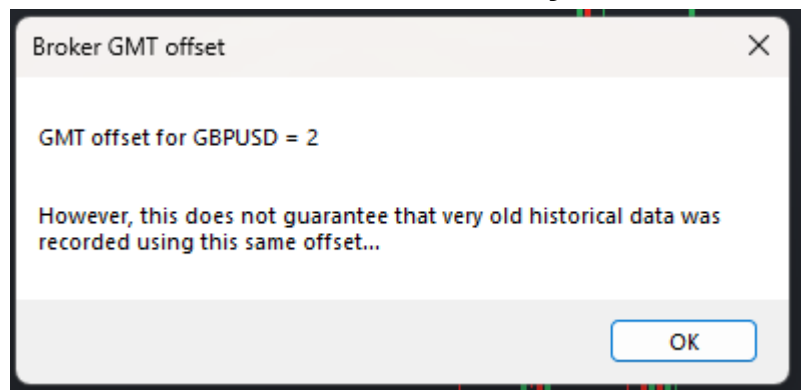
2. In the terminal Navigator, open the Scripts category.



3. Drag the Check GMT offset script onto the chart.



4. Done — the GMT used for that symbol will be displayed.

⚠ Make sure your broker uses a static GMT. In other words, the GMT offset must not have changed in the past due to broker rule changes or Daylight Saving Time
